Cookie policy

1 Information about our use of cookies

- 1.1 This policy explains how we use cookies on www.dmhall.co.uk (this “**Website**”). We recommend that you read our cookies policy so that you are aware of how we use them and can take steps to reject or delete the cookies if you do not agree to them being used.
- 1.2 Cookies are small text files stored on your device and used by website operators in order to make websites work, or work more efficiently, as well as to provide information to the operators of the website or certain third parties. Each cookie usually contains a unique string of characters, which allows a website to distinguish your browser or device from other users. In this cookies policy, we also use the term "cookie" to mean any other similar technology, such as web beacons, local stored objects (such as "Flash cookies"), and pixel tags.
- 1.3 We use cookies to enable you to navigate between pages and to generally improve your user experience. We also use cookies to analyse how users interact with this Website, to enable you to share content using social media, and to provide you with embedded content from third parties. We also sometimes use cookie type technologies in emails to identify how users come to this Website so that we can evaluate and measure the effectiveness of our email marketing.
- 1.4 We may combine information collected via cookies with information such as your IP address, the type of browser, device and operating system, for example to provide statistical information about visitors to the Website. Where this Website uses third party cookies, you should check with the relevant third party to see how they use cookies (see section 2 below).

2 Cookies we use

We use the following cookies on this Website:

- 2.1 **Strictly necessary cookies.** These are cookies that are required for the operation of this Website. We do not use any cookies on our website that are strictly necessary.
- 2.2 **Analytical/performance cookies.** They allow us to recognise and count the number of visitors and to see how visitors move around this Website when they are using it. This helps us to improve the way this Website works, for example, by ensuring that users are finding what they are looking for easily.

	<code>_gac_<property-id></code>	Contains campaign related information for the user. If you have linked your Google Analytics and AdWords accounts, AdWords website conversion tags will read this cookie unless you opt-out.	90 days

2.4 **Targeting cookies.** We do not use targeting cookies on our website.

2.5 **Third Party Cookies.** We do not use third party cookies on our website.

3.1 We will not deploy any cookies without your consent. Upon visiting our site, visitors will be provided with a cookie message allowing them to accept or decline the Google Analytics cookie.

3.2 If you wish to use this Website and do not consent to the use of cookies, you can block cookies by activating the setting on your browser or device that allows you to refuse the setting of all or some cookies.
